WHAT IS FLUX

FLUX is an open-source chronological photography publishing and archival system. Every 50 photographs automatically becomes a new issue.

The system generates:

- PDF publication
- contact sheet
- metadata manifest
- original JPEG files
- digital archive update

STEP_01

CAPTURE

CAMERA: compact digital camera

FILE TYPE: small JPEG

COLOR MODE: high contrast black and white

PURPOSE:

- eliminate processing
- eliminate workflow friction
- maximize speed

SELECT

GENERATE DIGITAL CONTACT SHEET

REVIEW SMALL THUMBNAILS ONLY

MAKE FINAL SELECTIONS

Philly fires kill three people in two days

Three people died in fires in Philadelphia in the last two days — two who perished Saturday morning in Northeast Philadelphia, and one who died Friday morning in a blaze declared an arson that has resulted in a man being charged with murder.

Just after 7:30 a.m. Saturday, the Philadelphia Fire Department responded to a fire in the 900 block of Granite Street, according to fire department and Philadelphia Police Department statements.

The first floor of a two-story residence was engulfed in flames while heavy smoke poured out of the second floor. Designated as an "all hands" response, the fire required more than 50 firefighters who contained the blaze before 8 a.m.

The two people who were pronounced dead at the scene were identified as an 8-year-old girl and a 31-year-old woman.

Among four survivors, a 3-year-old boy was taken to St. Charles's Hospital for Children in critical condition with burns to his arms, legs, and back. A 32-year-old man was taken to Temple University Hospital in critical condition with burns to his face and neck, and a 28-year-old woman was taken to the same hospital with burns to her face and neck.

The fire spread to neighboring homes, causing significant damage, police said.

Shadeak McDowell, 38, was taken into custody at the scene after being charged with murder. Police did not disclose other information about the case.

The Red Cross said it has provided relief to six families from the smoke and flames were roof of the building. Firefighters from the city's Harrowgate section that allegedly was an elderly man who is located on Locust Street.

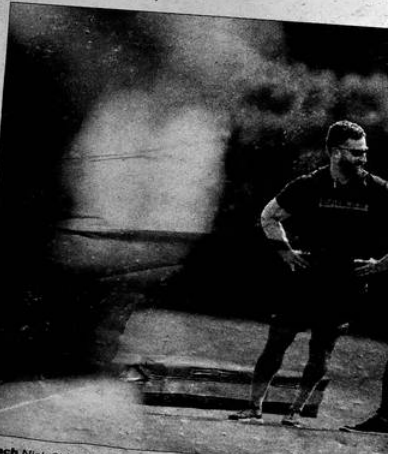
The film is in the can, so to speak, and general manager Howie Roseman and coach Nick Sirianni can focus their attention on the last few pieces to their roster puzzles. Roseman could also make moves before cut-down day. He already traded for wide receiver Jahan Dotson on Thursday.

He also has time after Tuesday to upgrade his team before the season opener vs. the Packers in Linnell on Sept. 6.

That's why the last few who make the initial roster shouldn't rest, and those who didn't shouldn't despair.

Every year the Eagles have players who are released in the first week after the making the bubble roster. Some are practice squad players who play in games and eventually promoted to the 53-man roster.

Roseman and Sirianni also may be able to factor into the picture. Consideration among them may include cap implications and importance. They will weigh the importance of one player over another. And they will try to make the short-

Considering all the above — and whatever info information has been gathered — Roseman has had reports of roster production.

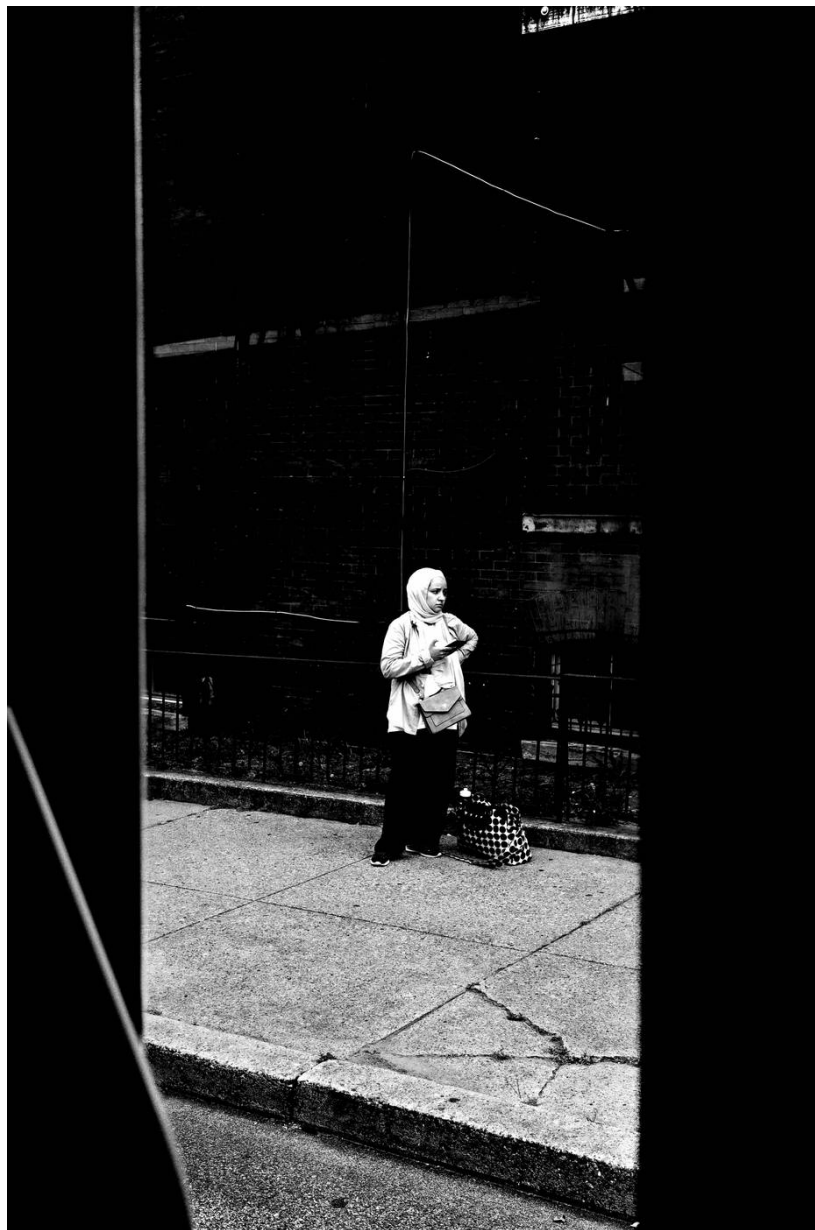

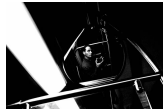
